

2018 Midterm Election Ballot Breakdown

Statewide Ballot Measures:

- I-1639 - This initiative from the Alliance for Gun Responsibility is the most comprehensive gun violence prevention measure put forth in our state's history. (Endorsed by Fuse WA, Washington Education Association, City of Kirkland)
- I-1631 - This initiative will charge our state's largest corporate polluters a fee that will be used to create local jobs by investing in clean energy, healthy forests, and clean water. (Endorsed by Fuse WA, WA Conservation Voters, Sierra Club)
- I-940 - This was originally an initiative to the legislature, but is now on the November ballot. This law would update our state's laws around police training and accountability. (Endorsed by Fuse WA)
- I-1634 - This initiative is funded by soda companies and would prohibit new or increased local taxes or fees on beverages and food. (Groceries are exempt from state sales tax.)

Kirkland Ballot Measure:

- Proposition 1: This ballot measure will raise \$1.8 million annually to go towards meeting the community safety needs of Kirkland. (Endorsed by Fuse WA)
