



## Indivisible Kirkland Volunteer Position: Issue Tracker

In preparation for the upcoming state legislative session, Indivisible Kirkland is looking to build a small team of people who are interested in legislative issues.

### **Positions available:**

Climate Tracker (2-3 open positions)  
Gun Safety Tracker (1-2 open positions)  
Health Care/Reproductive Rights Tracker (2 open positions)  
Immigration Rights Tracker (1 open position)  
Social Justice Tracker (1-2 open positions)  
Democracy Tracker (1-2 open positions)

**Purpose:** To help Indivisible Kirkland stay aware of state legislative actions and bills related to the issue you're tracking. Your focused attention on a specific issue and small set of bills will allow us to stay up-to-date and better informed about the happenings in Olympia in the 2019 legislative session. This information will help guide our steering committee in directing the membership towards action. You will essentially act as an information conduit between Olympia and our steering team so that we can advocate for our issues as effectively as possible during the session, which runs from January to April.

**Responsibilities:** Track bills and important events related to your issue, and report back to the steering committee. Much of this information may be relayed through email and on slack (and can be done at home, around your schedule), but there might be opportunities to attend steering meetings. This position runs from January to April, with some potential training in December or very early January.

**Qualifications:** Member of Indivisible Kirkland. A desire to learn more about the legislative process and make an impact in Kirkland and in the state of Washington.

**Training:** You will have the opportunity for plenty of training. This training can include: navigating the state legislature's site, the legislative process, tracking bills, utilizing all organizations to gather information, using slack for team communications, and pretty much anything else you need. Our steering committee will be available to answer questions and provide guidance. (All of this is said with the caveat that we're learning as we go, too! It's amazing to think about how much we've learned and how much we still don't know. This upcoming session, just like last session, will be an adventure for all of us!)
