### Getting Ready for the 2019 Legislative Session

The 2019 Washington State Legislative Session starts on January 14th! Before the frenzy of the session is a great time to remind our legislators of the issues we care about.

#### Upcoming Bills:

- 1) Keep Washington Working Act: This bill recognizes the contributions of immigrants to our economy and ensures that state and local resources are not used for immigration enforcement.
- 2) SB 5062: This bill, which is sponsored by Senator Kuderer, bans high capacity magazines in Washington.
- 3) HB 2294 (that's the bill number from 2018; remains to be seen what the bill number will be this year): Aligning Washington's greenhouse gas emissions with the 2015 Paris Climate Agreement. Representative Slatter will sponsor this bill again this year.
- 4) HB 1053 & HB 1054: Providing sales and tax exemptions for feminine hygiene products and diapers.
