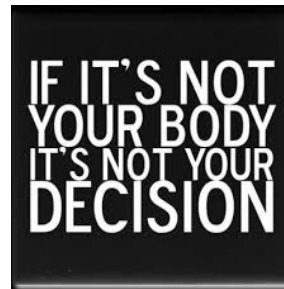

NO WAR WITH IRAN

ACTION ITEM: The drumbeat for war is getting louder with John Bolton leading the charge. The ramifications, if successful, are disastrous. Congress must exercise its constitutional authority over war-making, as a bare minimum.

Senator Udall of NM, has introduced S. 1039, the Prevention of Unconstitutional War with Iran Act. There are currently 17 co-sponsors. **NEITHER SENATOR CANTWELL or MURRAY has co-sponsored this bill.** This lack of action is irresponsible.

CALL both Senators to urgently push them to co-sponsor this bill with this straightforward message, "We in Washington urgently need you to be a leader to stop a war with Iran. Join 17 of your colleagues to act - now...co sponsor **S. 1039, the Prevention of Unconstitutional War with Iran Act.**"
